Public Participation and Involvement

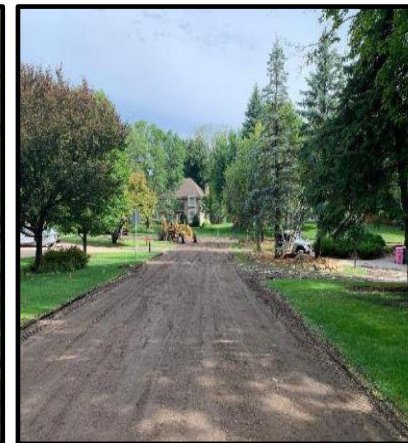
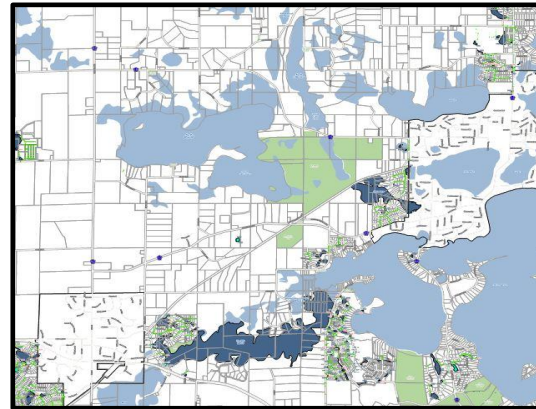
- MS4 Annual Board was published for the month of December on the City's webpage

Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination

- Documentation and response to an illicit discharge
- Illicit discharge enforcement action
 - Zero (0) illicit discharges reported in 2020
- City field staff received illicit discharge training

Minimum Control Measure 4 & 5
Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control
Post-Construction Stormwater Management

- Twenty-one (21) active construction sites equal to or greater than 1 acre requiring a NPDES permit
- Zero (0) enforcement actions reported in 2020



Minimum Control Measure 6
Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping

- Quarterly Public Works inspections and maintenance
- Public works staff training
- Completed required inspections for stormwater infrastructure:
 - BMP inspections – 5
 - Outfall inspections - 60
 - Pond Inspections - 9
 - BMP maintenance
