BURN PILE REQUIREMENTS

- 1) The pile must be established and will be inspected by an authorized city official.
- 2) The burn pile must be set back a minimum of 100 feet from any structure.
- 3) All fires must be surrounded by a 5 foot non-combustible area.
- 4) All requirements of this permit must be followed.

FIRE SAFETY AND AIR QUALITY REQUIREMENTS

I Agree to:


- Keep this fire under control and to assume responsibility for all damages and cost that may result from burning done under this permit.
- Attend to this fire until completely extinguished.
- Not burn if there is a practical alternative method for disposal of the material (chipping/compost)
- Use a clean burning device to start the fire.
- Not conduct burning during any air quality alert.
- Use proper farm disposal of solid waste as provided under MN Statutes 17.135
- Extinguish the fire immediately if this permit is revoked.
- Have this permit available at the burn site for inspection.
- See that prevailing winds must be away from nearby occupied buildings.
- Not allow the fire to smolder without flame.

**** No person shall start or maintain any open fire, or cause, suffer, allow, or permit an open fire within the city for the purpose of disposing of garbage, refuse, plastics or other wastes of this nature or wastes producing an unreasonable amount of air contaminants except as may be authorized by permit of any agency or governmental body having jurisdiction. (Minnetrista City Code 1103.15; MN Statutes 471.62, 116.01 et seq.)**

This permit is valid for open burning as allowed and specified in MN Statutes 88.03 to 88.22, Minnesota Uniform Fire Code, and local ordinances. The applicant is granted permission to burn the above described materials at the specified location during the time frame listed above. I attest, by my signature, that I have read and will comply with the conditions of, and my attachments to this permit, and that I am the landowner or have permission from the landowner to burn at the specified burn site location.

Oils, rubber, plastic, tires, and chemically treated materials such as railroad ties, treated lumber, composite shingles, tar paper, insulation, composition board, sheetrock, wiring, paint, hazardous and industrial solid waste.
