Hennepin County Partners with City of Minnetrista

Hennepin County and the City of Minnetrista partner to build out broadband infrastructure and provide high-quality internet service to nearly 500 unserved and underserved homes in Minnetrista. There has been a gap in the availability of reliable high speed internet service in the City of Minnetrista and other communities which has been exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. Providing reliable internet services to unserved and underserved homes has been one of the City Council's top priorities.

On February 7, 2022, the City Council approved a cost share agreement with Midco for the build out of fiber to the home internet to unserved and underserved homes. With Hennepin County's commitment to eliminate the digital divide, and financial support in the amount of \$200,000, the City of Minnetrista is able to further bridge the gap in high-speed internet service in the community.
