Polling Place Location Agreements Approved

In addition to Precinct 2A (Minnetrista City Hall) and Precinct 4A (Minnetrista Police Training Facility), the City will be using two additional non-municipal buildings for Precincts 1A and 3A, that being Westonka School Administrative Office and Freshwater Community Church respectively. The building use is donated to the City.

Improvements Accepted and Final Payment Authorized for Kings Point Rd Watermain Repair Project

The Kings Point Rd Watermain Repair Project has been satisfactorily completed and the project acceptance and final payment to the contractor have been authorized. The total payment made to Parrott Contracting Inc. will be \$103,639.34.

Public Hearing Held for 2020 Street Improvement Project; Preparation of Plans and Specifications Authorized

A Public Hearing is required per MS Chapter 429 to allow interested persons to voice their opinions of the proposed improvements, whether or not they are in the proposed assessment area. There were six Minnetrista residents who spoke in front of the Council regarding the project. The estimated probable cost for the project is \$832,523.08 which is proposed to be funded through a combination of City Funds and Special Assessments to the benefiting properties. The City's assessment policy is to assess 50% of the improvements in a street reclamation or reconstruction project. The preliminary residential unit assessment rate is \$7,587.83 per unit.
