Purchase of Turnout Gear from City of St. Bonifacius Approved

The City of St. Bonifacius will be using \$15,000 out of the Budget Reserve Fund to purchase turnout gear necessary to safely enter fire areas as determined by Occupational Safety and Health Administration. This will not have a fiscal impact on the amount the City of Minnetrista is paying per our 2020 contract fire services with St. Bonifacius

Mayor Declares Local Emergency & Meetings to be Conducted by Telephone/Electronic Means

Due to the pandemic declarations relating to COVID-19 made recently by the World Health organization, President of the US, and Governor of the State of MN, effective Monday, March 23, 2020, Minnetrista Mayor Lisa Whalen has declared a Local Emergency. This mayoral Declaration is to declare the emergency for the City of Minnetrista as well as to protect the health, safety, and welfare of residents. Additionally, this declaration will protect City property and will help provide essential City services as efficiently as possible.

Following this declaration, Mayor Whalen made a declaration to Extend the Local Emergency until further notice.

Prior to this Declaration of Emergency, Mayor Whalen signed a statement which authorizes the City to meet by telephone or other electronic means to conduct business. If it is deemed not practical or prudent to hold the meeting in person due to a declared health pandemic or emergency, meetings will be conducted virtually. This action is to protect the health, safety, and welfare of residents and property of the City.
