As recommended by the Personnel Committee, the City Council approved the full employment offer for Nikki Myhre as a Police Officer with the Minnetrista Police Department.

Professional Services Agreement for the 2020 Sewer Lining Project

The City Council has approved the Professional Service Agreement Authorizing preparation of a quote package for the 2020 Sewer Lining Project.

The Public Works department has identified various portions of sanitary sewer and storm sewer throughout the city that are in need of rehabilitation. At this time, there are 20 segments proposed for a cured-in-place epoxy resin pipe liner (CIPP.) This project will help reduce infiltration into the sanitary sewer and extend the life of the City's sewer infrastructure.

WSB prepared a professional services agreement to prepare a quote package for contractors and administer construction services. The proposed fee is hourly not to exceed \$14,230. Construction is proposed to begin in July– August 2020 and be completed in September 2020.

Professional Services Agreement for the 2020 Crack Fill Project

Public Works has indicated that Game Farm Road East, Game Farm Road North, and Kings Point Road would benefit from a crack fill project. Due to the minor cracking typical of streets this age, this type of maintenance would extend the life of these roads.

WSB prepared a Professional Services Agreement to prepare a quote package and administer constructions services with a proposed fee is hourly not to exceed \$6,992. The City Council approved the Professional Services Agreement authorizing the preparation of a quote package. The construction is proposed to begin July 2020 and be completed July 2020.
