Swearing In of Police Officer Patrick Johnson

The swearing-in ceremony for Minnetrista Police Officer Patrick Johnson was held on Monday, July 18, 2022 at City of Minnetrista City Hall where Officer Johnson took the Minnetrista Public Safety Department Oath of Honor. Officer Johnson was hired on May 31, 2022 and is currently in field training. We expect him to be on patrol in the next few weeks.

Officer Johnson graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from the University of North Dakota. He began his law enforcement career in the City of Medina as a Community Service Officer for two years. Midco Broadband Expansion Project

The City Council approved an addition to the Midco Broadband Expansion project scope. On February 7, 2022, the City Council approved an agreement with Midco to build out broadband services to nearly 500 homes. Since then, Midco and the City have uncovered additional unserved areas that were not included in this initial project. Hennepin County, the City of Minnetrista, and Midco have partnered once again to build out broadband services to an additional 20 homes in the Dutchview Road, Woodedge Road, and West-edge Boulevard area. Mackenthun's Concept Plan

The City Council reviewed the concept plan for Mackenthun's and discussed various concerns about the new development.

Mackenthun's submitted an application for a concept plan review of a grocery store and multifamily apartment building located within the Woodland Cove Development. This plan was reviewed by the Planning Commission at the June meeting and their concerns were acknowledged.

A concept plan does not require any official action. City Council provided their feedback and this plan will come back for formal approval in the future.
