



Completion dates are dependent upon favorable weather conditions.

What should you expect as construction progresses?

Construction scope varies depending on the street that your property is adjacent to. Streets that are proposed to for **pavement mill and overlay** include Burl Oaks Ct, Burl Oaks Dr, Pheasant Xing, Hunters Ct, and Glacier Ct. Streets that are proposed to be **reclaimed** include D'Chene Ln, D'Chene Cir, and Ox Yoke Cir. A segment of the approach to County Road 26 on Ingerson Rd is proposed to be **paved with bituminous pavement**.

Construction activities will occur generally as follows:

- Placement of erosion control devices
- Placement of construction survey stakes
- Excavation and installation of pipe culverts
- Milling or reclamation of the existing pavement
- Spot concrete curb and gutter repair for milled areas
- Filling of soil in areas where the roadway is raised
- Grading and placing bituminous for pavement
- Restoration grading and topsoil placement
- Establishment of vegetation
- General cleanup of the site

Property Owner Responsibility

If you have special needs for access or if you have an appointment and you need to leave by a certain time and day, please let Matt know at least a day ahead of time so he can help make arrangements for access.

If you are anticipating a special delivery, open house, or any other activity during the construction schedule, please notify Matt of the time and date this will occur. The contractor and project staff will do their best to provide access as necessary.
